JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM 2007

The MG Car Club of Tasmania Inc., with the assistance of the Confederation of Australian Motorsport (CAMS), will be running a series of motorkhanas as an introduction to motorsport for juniors.

These events will be open to juniors between the ages of 12 & 17 to enable them to experience motor sport at an entry level, in a controlled environment, under the supervision of club members.

Program outline:
