#### **Starter Motor for Magnettes**



As you may know a Holden Gemini starter motor fits straight in to the

ZA/ZB Magnette and is much more efficient. So if like me you want to

keep the original starter in tip top condition then you can usually get a Gemini TE starter on ebay or from most wreckers for about \$70-80.

Wiring it in is easy. As the ttached picture shows just make a jumper wire, fit to the terminal shown, fit the starter to the car then connect

you main cable to the terminal shown by the end of the pen. No need to touch your solenoid or wiring.

Hope this suggestion is useful


