A Chat with Richard Ashley-Jones

Richard's interest in cars dates back to when he was 17 years old as he needed to get from point A to point B. It was as simple as that and the start of a strong interest in motoring.

In 1965 Richard bought a Mini and joined the Light Car Club of Tasmania (LCCT). Richard has always been closely involved with the LCCT and in the early years before having a family and setting up his own business, was involved in doing a lot of work at Symmons Plains. Note - I'm happy to admit that I hadn't heard of the LCCT but now know it's the oldest continuously operating Tasmanian Car Club, is located in Launceston and is part of the spectator sports industry.


In 1965-66 Richard was Flag Marshall and along with Wayne Brooks started the final two Longfords and saw up close and personal the likes of Jack Brabham, Graham Hill and James Clark who all competed in the Australian Grand Prix at Longford. In those days, to start the racing at Longford, Richard and Wayne were put in an apple box and lifted up and partially out over the start line which was a magnificent place to watch the races. Richard said it was an amazing opportunity being present at the drivers meeting before the Grand Prix to meet and talk with the drivers. "They all got on extremely well in that era - Jack Brabham was a true gentleman and Jimmy Clark was hilarious".

In 1966 Richard bought a 1953 MG TD but sold it after 6 months for £250 as he needed the cash to repay a loan from his father. Richard had advertised both the Mini and the TD. If he had sold the Mini and retained the TD he might have joined the MG Car Club sooner! Interestingly, the whereabouts of the TD was unknown to Richard for 30 years. In an article by Peter Scott, Richard realised the car owned by John James was his old car. Nothing particularly remarkable about this except John lives only 200 metres from Richard's home and although he regularly saw the car, didn't realise it was his old car!

Also in 1966, Richard bought a Mk 3A Sprite which he ran at club days at Symmons Plains. A picture of Richard with his Sprite at Punchbowl is below.



In 1967 Richard bought a GT Cortina from Bruce Gowans which he had for 2 years as his regular car. Richard said it was a beautiful car (pictured below) which he ran at Symmons Plains in Club events. On the Club days at Symmons Plains, Richard achieved lap times of 1 minute 26 seconds in the Sprite, and a quicker 1 minute 18 seconds in the Cortina. This was very commendable as the times were set with standard tyres and suspension.



This love of motoring and racing eventually led to Richard entering Targa in 1993 as a navigator with Steve Bye as driver. Together they converted a wrecked 1967 Fastback GT350 R (below) to make it Targa compliant. They had a good run but one Targa was enough due to the danger and inherent problems Richard understood from his racing days at Symmons Plains. Richard said "It was an achievement to complete Targa as it was wet and dangerous particularly through Rosebery where cars were travelling at frightening speeds".







In 2010 Richard bought his beloved red 1977 MGB and joined the MG Car Club. His MGB had the rubber bumpers removed, was lowered to make it more traditional, and has a five-speed Mazda gearbox with electronic ignition.

After 10 years association with the MG Car Club he joined the committee for one month before rising to the dizzy heights of Chairman of the Northern Sub Centre Committee earlier this year. As always, when you want something done, you ask a busy person and Richard is busy with his statewide sales and

distribution business which he has owned for 50 years, golfing on Wednesdays and boating and saltwater fishing when he can. The role of Chairman filled a small gap as he wasn't able to go snow skiing! Richard said that during Covid more was being done - it had been a terrific year for the Northern Sub Centre with great support for events and a large number of well attended functions and interesting runs.

Richard has owned over 20 cars including Falcons, Volvos, Range Rovers, Land Rovers, Mercedes but his favourite car that he owned was an original two-door 1977 blue Range Rover which had done over 350,000km. He said he should never have sold it! In a perfect world Richard said he would have an MGB GT V8.

You will note in the photos that Richard is often sitting on the right hand front mudguard of his cars. It is a tradition of his. The more observant of you might note the small LCCT badge proudly placed on the grill in many of the photos.

Finally, my thanks to the affable Richard for making time at such short notice to have a chat with me during my brief stay in sunny Launceston.




